### TRANSITION DAY

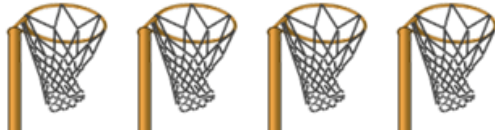
