We have recently had an increasing amount of food waste, especially at KS1. Parents/carers of all full-time children are given a meal option sheet each week to select their lunch. We ask that these are completed and returned by each **Wednesday**. This allows the kitchen chance to accurately order from our suppliers. If your child does not submit a lunch order, where possible a reminder text will be sent. If we do not receive an order, your child will be recorded as a home packed lunch. You are reminded that orders cannot be changed on the day as we may not be able to provide a hot meal at short notice.

May we please remind all parents/carers that children in Years 1 - 6 require their P.E Kit in school from a Monday. We recommend these are taken home to wash on a Friday. There are also many children who forget to take home their water bottle to clean each Friday.
