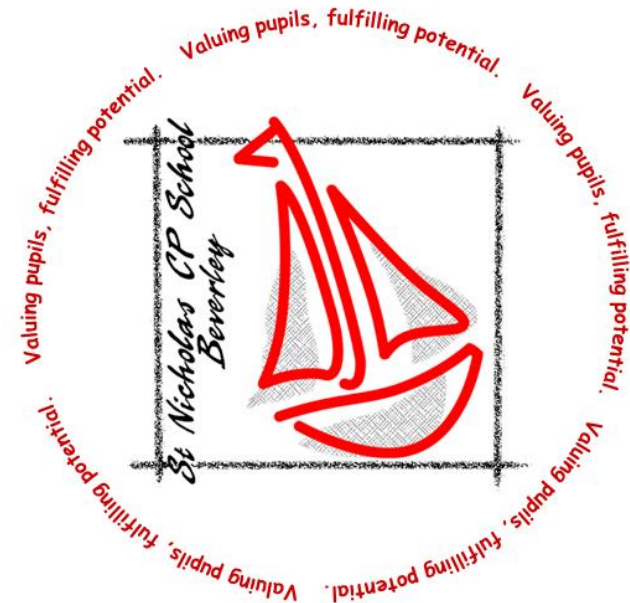

We will provide homework on the *My Maths* website which will be set every Friday. The children will have 2 weeks to complete this homework. Additionally please encourage your child to read daily. This can be either a school reading book or a book of their own.

For **Literacy** this term, children will be grouped to work on their reading and writing skills using *Read, Write Inc* and Literacy and Language packages. All children will have daily Spelling and handwriting lessons.

In **Maths**, we will be ensuring that we are improving our mental maths speed. We will continue to study place value and focus on the four modes of operation: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

In **Science** we will be looking at *Animals & Health*, investigating how we grow and stay healthy.

Our **Topic** for the first half term will be 'Chocolate'. Children will look at the origins of chocolate and how it became popular. They will look at the production of chocolate and its effect on the York area. They will also be designing and manufacturing their own chocolate bar for sale as an enterprise project.

In **RE** we will be looking at 'Belonging' and our role in groups and the community. We will also be learning about stories from different faiths.

Within **computing** we will be learning to use the internet and computer programmes to communicate effectively and safely. We will be creating presentations and documents and start to learn basic coding.

In **PE** we will be learning multi skills where we will improve our ball skills, control and game tactics. We will be working to improve our fitness. Later in the term we will also be learning dance.
