

This term, our work in **Literacy** will start with units on poetic language and Non-chronological reports. In line with the new curriculum, there will continue to be a greater emphasis placed on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In **Numeracy**, we will be ensuring we can use place value to order numbers and partition, recognise and continue number patterns and confidently use the four operations. We will also be focusing on securing our knowledge of times tables.

In **Science**, children will be learning about the wonders of light, including reflections and shadows.

Our **History** topic for the term will be 'Captain Caveman', during which we will be learning about the life and beliefs' of the Stone Age to Bronze Age people of Britain. Throughout this topic, pupils will be developing a range of historical, Art and Design and Technology skills.

In **French**, children will learn how to introduce themselves, greet others and say how they are. They will begin to respond to and ask questions about name and age. We are focusing on New Beginnings in **SEAL**, and communities in **RE**. Within **ICT** we will be looking at Internet safety.

In **PE**, we will cover a range of topics, including dance, games and gymnastics. We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child has their PE kit and suitable footwear in school throughout the week. Swimming details will be sent as a separate letter.
