


In line with our Home School Agreement, we would welcome your support by:-


This booklet provides you with some general information on the subjects that will be covered by your child this term.

This term, in year 5/6, our work in Literacy will focus on narrative writing, linking with our Literacy and Language programme.

In Numeracy, we will be ensuring children have a firm grasp of place value, calculations and fractions.

In Science we will be studying Earth and Space and Forces.

In French we will learn about transport.

Our History topic for the term will be 'Is it right to fight?– Britain since the 1930s'. During this topic, we will be designing and making an air raid shelter.

We are focusing on New Beginnings, Getting on and Falling Out and saying No to Bullying in SEAL, and Religious Expression in RE.

Within computing we will be looking at E-Safety, using the internet and creating an app.

We will be learning how Music has developed and continue to appraise, compose and perform using Charanga.

In PE, we will be teaching Invasion Games and then Gymnastics. Ensure that your child has their PE kit and suitable footwear in school throughout the week please.
